***Validity of application is subject to fulfillment of minimum eligibility  
criteria, uploading of required documents and online payment of  
application fee within the stipulated date and time.***

***Applicants are required to fill up every field of the online application  
form carefully. Admission is liable to be cancelled at the time of  
verification of documents for any incorrect entry.***

*Admission to the college is granted on the understanding that the student undertakes to conform in all respects to the rules and discipline of Bethune College and the University of Calcutta.*

#### **General Information and Requirement for Admission:**

- A candidate who passed the Higher Secondary or its equivalent Examination (10+2 level) in 2020, 2019 or 2018 from any recognized Board is eligible to apply for admission to the B.A. / B.Sc./B.Com. (Honours/General) courses.
- Candidates who passed in Vocational Stream are not eligible to apply for Honours Courses.
- **Aggregate** marks shall be calculated by adding the marks of the **BEST FOUR** subjects (at least 100 marks paper). Marks in compulsory Environmental Education / Studies will not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks.
- Admission will be conducted strictly on the basis of merit. The subject wise merit lists will be prepared based on corresponding **INDEX MARK** for all categories of students.
- **SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B candidates from only West Bengal are eligible for reservation benefits.**
- Admission to any course of the college is provisional and is subject to final approval of the West Bengal State University
- Anti-ragging declaration as mandated by the UGC is to be submitted online by every student after admission, failing which the registration process will not be initiated.

#### **Documents required to be uploaded at the time of online form fill up:**

**Keep the scanned copies of the following documents (in .jpg format) (maximum file size and resolution is given within parenthesis for each document) ready before online form fill up.**

1. Recent Passport size colour Photograph (50KB)
2. Signature (25 KB)

3. Age Proof (preferably admit card of Madhyamik or equivalent Exam)(Less than 200KB)
4. Mark Sheet of 10+2 level )(Not more than 200KB)

Besides these the following documents are also required, if applicable:

5. Caste Certificate (for SC/ST/OBC category candidates) (Not more than 200 KB)
6. PWD (Persons with physical disabilities/Physically handicapped) Certificate (100 KB)

### **Eligibility Criterion**

An applicant must have valid own e-mail id (not an e-mail id of cyber cafe) and permanent mobile number.

- A Candidate taking up Honours Course in a subject must have obtained:

- A minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate and 45% marks in the subject or related Subject at the previous qualifying examination.

OR

- 55% marks in the subject or related Subject at the previous qualifying examination.

OR

- 50% marks in the aggregate when the candidate has not studied the subject in his/her previous qualifying examination provided all the other clauses are satisfied.

### **Candidates belonging to Schedule Cast or Schedule Tribe Community**

Candidates belonging to Schedule Cast or Schedule Tribe community taking up Honours Course or study must have obtained a minimum of 40% marks in the aggregate and 40% marks in the subject or related Subject at the previous qualifying examination, as the case may be. Caste Certificate Issued and signed by appropriate authorities not below the rank of SDO of West Bengal Government can be acceptable fail to provide then your admission will be cancelled other state candidate who belong to SC,ST,OBC-A and OBC-B category are treated as a GENERAL candidate as per rule.

**FOR OTHER BOARD CANDIDATES:**Except WBCHSE, CBSC, ISC and National Institute of Open Schooling, other board candidates have to submit the Migration Certificate for getting Registration under the University

### **Reservation of seats:**

- . Reservation Policy for admission shall be guided by the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission), Act 2013 and Rules, 2014. Number of Reserved seats for Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, OBC-A & OBC-B are shown against each Honours subject.
- For Persons with Disabilities (PWD) candidates 5% of seats are reserved in each category in terms of G.O. No. 1084(20)-Edn(U)/EH/1U-89/13 dated 07.12.18 of Dept. of Higher Education, Govt. of West Bengal

### A. For Honours Students [অনার্স ছাত্রছাত্রীদের জন্য]

**Step-I :** Students are required to choose any one Honours subject (Core Course) from Table 1 given below: [অনার্স পড়তে ইচ্ছুক ছাত্রছাত্রীদের নিম্নলিখিত টেবিল-1 থেকে একটি বিষয় (Core Course) পছন্দ করতে হবে।]:

**Step-II :** Honours students (except Geography, B.Sc and Accountancy Honours) are required to choose two General subjects i.e. Generic Electives (GEs) GE-I for SEM-I (Paper-I), SEM-II (Paper-II) and GE-II for SEM-III (Paper-III), SEM-IV (Paper-IV) from the following Table-2.[অনার্সের ছাত্রছাত্রীরা (Geography, B.Sc. and Accountancy Honours বাদে) নিম্নলিখিত টেবিল-2 থেকে দুটি জেনারেল বিষয় Generic Electives (GEs), GE-I সেমিস্টার-I (পেপার-1), সেমিস্টার-II (পেপার-2) এবং GE-II সেমিস্টার-III (পেপার-3), সেমিস্টার-IV (পেপার-4) পছন্দ করতে পারবে। ]

In Table 2, there are four groups and students can choose only **ONE subject** from each group as GE. Geography (Honours. B.Sc.) Students are required to choose any **TWO subjects from the four groups subject to maximum one subject from each group.** [ভূগোল অনার্স পড়তে ইচ্ছুক ছাত্রছাত্রীরা নিম্নলিখিত টেবিল-3 র চারটি গ্রুপ থেকে সর্বাধিক দুটি বিষয় এবং প্রতিটি গ্রুপ থেকে কেবলমাত্র একটি বিষয় পছন্দ করতে পারবে।]

**Step-III :** All Honours students have to take Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC) as **Compulsory Subject in SEM-I & II**. Students have to take Environmental Science (ENVS) as compulsory AECC for SEM I. In SEM-II, Honours students have to opt **either for English Communications or MIL (Bengali or Sanskrit) as AECC**. ### **B. For General Students** [জেনারেল ছাত্রছাত্রীদের জন্য]

**Step-I :** General students (except Geography, B.Sc.) are required to choose two General subjects i.e. Core Courses (GCOR 1 & GCOR 2) from the following Table-4 for SEM I to IV. In Table 4, there are four groups and students can choose only **ONE subject** from each group as COR. Please note that a student can choose **a maximum of two subjects** from Table-4. **In addition General students (except Geography)** have to take Language through Literature (English) for SEM I & II and Modern Indian Language (namely Bengali) for SEM III & IV as compulsory General subject i.e. Core Courses (GCOR-3). **Only for Geography General students (B.Sc. General)** [শুধুমাত্র ভূগোল জেনারেল ছাত্রছাত্রীদের জন্য যারা **B.Sc. General** ]

Geography (General) students are required to choose *Two subjects (apart from Geography) from the following four groups (Table-5) subject to maximum one subject as COR from each group.* [টেবিল-5 এ চারটি গ্রুপ থেকে ভূগোল জেনারেল ছাত্রছাত্রীরা আরও দুটি বিষয়(ভূগোল বাদে) পছন্দ করতে পারবে এবং প্রতিটি গ্রুপ থেকে সর্বাধিক একটিমাত্র বিষয় **COR** হিসাবে পছন্দ করতে পারবে।]

**Step-II** : All General students have to take Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC) as **compulsory subject in SEM-I & II**. Students have to take Environmental Science (ENVS) as compulsory AECC for SEM I. In SEM-II, General students have to opt **either for English Communications or MIL (Bengali or Sanskrit) as AECC**. **Step-III**: **General students (except Geography, B.Sc.)** also have to take one General subject (from Table-1) i.e. Generic Elective Course (GGEC) for SEM-V (Paper-I) and SEM -VI (Paper-II) apart from Core Courses (GCOR I & II) choosing from Table 4.
